## Terms of Entry - Please read carefully

**Ground fee : \$25.00** per horse

**Non Graded Classes entry fee:** \$17.00 per test - Rosettes only 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>

**Open Classes Entry Fee :** \$22.00 per test - Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> & prize money 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup>

**Prize money** \$40, \$30, \$20 open classes only (prize money only paid on tests achieving 57% or more)

**Late Entry Fee :** \$20 per horse (if class space allows)

**Entry fee must be paid by close of entries : no fee = no draw**

## **Additional Rosettes for Restricted Riders**

**Class 5 & 6** CN/C1 riders only : Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> **or** rosette from open placing -riders choice

**Class 9 & 10** CN/C1/C2 riders only: Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> **or** rosette from open placing -riders choice

- Horses not entered in the competition may only be on the grounds with the permission of the OC and ground fee must be paid.
- Payment to be made at same time as entry. Entry only processed once payment received.  
Payment received after close of entries may attract late fees.
- Note close of entries date, late entries may be accepted at the organisers discretion, but will incur a late fee of \$10 per test.  
Late entries will only be put into the draw AFTER full payment of entry received.
- All Classes are run under DNZ & ESNZ Rules. Bridle numbers must be worn at all times on registered horses - Arm Bands (from the secretary) must be worn by riders on non graded horses/ponies. Whilst on grounds and not under saddle, all horses/ponies **must** be wearing identification tag with name of horse, name of person responsible for horse on day and mobile contact number for that person.
- All entries for Open classes must be on official ESNZ entry forms with the appropriate stickers and fees or entered through Equestrian Entries online entries
- The horse must be entered in the correct class for its points regardless of the rider category as per article 460. So for example a horse with Level 3 points but a CN rider still has to enter level 3 or above.
- CN is a rider who has never received any grading points, C1 is a rider who has never received any Level 2 grading points or above, C2 is a rider who has never received any Level 3 grading points or above.
- Open classes earn grading points.
- Non Grading Classes are only for riders not members of ESNZ and either horse not registered for dressage with ESNZ, or non members on horses that may have previously earned less than 30 points at level 2, or horses registered for other disciplines but ridden by a non ESNZ member. A tidy dress code applies.

- The Dressage Waitemata Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to change the program.
- The Dressage Waitemata Committee accept no liability for damage, loss or injury to competitors, spectators or their property, in accordance with articles 114/160 of the NZEF general regulations.
- Horse welfare comes first with Dressage Waitemata - Maximum 3 tests per day
