

DRESSAGE WAITEMATA INTRODUCTORY DRESS CODE AND FURTHER INFORMATION

RIDER:

Safety approved helmet

Neat and tidy top / shirt – show jackets are optional

Clean jodhpurs / riding breeches (of any colour)

Jodhpur boots, riding boots, any style of chaps or gaiters (no gum boots)

Pony Club Uniform is ideal

HORSE:

Snaffle bridle (no bitless bridles allowed)

Any kind of saddle with a saddle cloth underneath

Please note you can warm your horse up in protective horse boots, but these are not allowed when you compete in your test.

FURTHER INFORMATION REGARDING THE INTRODUCTORY SCHEME

The introductory scheme is to encourage riders who are interested in trying Dressage, or who have taken part at other non registered days, to come along and try a registered day. They can meet with members and find out the advantages of becoming a member, they can talk to judges and hopefully become involved and then come along to education days etc.

So please pass this information on to friends and colleagues who ride and introduce them to the website and encourage them to take part.

A special entry form is on the Calendar page of our website and is to be printed off and used for the introductory riders. For these riders arm bands with a number will need to worn, and they can be obtained from the secretary on the day.

Introductory Riders will be given set times to ride, as with all of the registered combinations. Introductory Riders will need to look at the draw which will be posted on the website in the week prior to the competition to see what time they are competing.

A newcomer steward is available on the day, and committee members are available on hand to assist with first time competitors.
