



Championship Show - 13, 14 & 15 December 2013 Rider's Notes

Show Office

The show office will be open from 8am Friday and 7am Sat/ Sun. Please collect your riders bags (including programme) from the show office.

Rosettes will be available from office, 30mins after final scores are posted. Challenge classes, Zilco Musical classes and Dunstan Bonanza rosettes will be presented at prizegivings either Saturday or Sunday. Prize money for these classes can be collected from office prior to prize giving (check your programme for details).

Horse Identification

ESNZ require all horses/ ponies to display approved identification at all times. Bridle numbers when ridden and a cow tag or equivalent attached to the horse with horses name, owners name and contact number when "not in use". Please make sure your horse is identifiable, if there is a problem we want to be able to contact you immediately. Spare tags will be available from the office for \$2.00. Stewards will be checking through out the weekend that all horses are wearing their tags.

Horses on Grounds

Only horses competing in the championship show may be on the grounds during the show unless permission has been obtained from the O.C prior to the event.

Yarding

A yarding list will be posted by the yards, office and toilet block. Yarding must be paid for regardless of how long your horse is in there for. We have a limited number of covered yards, if you have paid for a covered yard but have been allocated a uncovered yard please see the office during the show for your refund. PLEASE LEAVE YOUR YARD CLEAN, fines will be issued to riders who leave their yards full of poo. Please use yard allocated to you, if your yard is not safe or usable for any reason please contact the office.

Show Grounds

The grounds will only be open from midday Thursday.

Warm Up

Please remind your trainers/ coaches that for safety reasons if they are warming you up they must stand at the edge of the warm up, not in the middle. We don't want to have to come out and ask them to move as this usually offends.

Prizegiving

There will be an unmounted prizegiving Saturday evening and the final prizegiving on Sunday afternoon. Please check your programme for more details. Due to the large number of entries, level 1 & 2 classes and Dunstan Bonanza have rosettes and prize money to 8th, other levels have rosettes to 6th and prizemoney to 4th.
