Product prizes – classes 38 -39

**Entry fee** - \$25 per test

**Late Entry fee**- \$40 per horse

**Ground Fee** - \$30 per horse if two or three days entered or \$25 if riding only one day

**Admin Fee** - \$15 per rider non-refundable **Online entry fee** \$1.25 per test non refundable

**Fees paid after close of entries will incur late fee.** Riders will not be entered into draw until all fees paid.

**Yarding** - allocated as entry & payment is received.

**Open pen** \$25.00 for weekend

**Covered Yard** (limited) \$50.00 for weekend.

Some Stallion accommodation is available, open & covered but must be clearly requested -for stallions only.

Stallion yards - \$50 for weekend covered and \$25 uncovered.

**Camping** per Truck/float with 2 or less occupants \$20.00 for the weekend. More than 2 occupants \$25 for weekend

**Rosettes** : All Classes 1st - 6th No equal placings will be awarded, count backs will be applied where necessary

Restricted Rider Rosettes: Level 1 CN/C1 riders only : Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> or rosette from open placing -riders choice

: Level 2 CN/C1/C2 riders only :Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> or rosette from open placing -riders choice

**Hanoverian Sash** – One sash awarded for Level 1-3 & one awarded for Level 4-9

Entries can be made online at [www.equestrianentries.co.nz](http://www.equestrianentries.co.nz) with credit card payment available through paypal or direct credit through Poli at time of entry. Any special requirements need to be included with entry

Entry can be made on official ESNZ form & posted to Dressage Waitemata P O Box 506, Kumeu with cheque. Must be received by close of entries or will be deemed a late entry

**Pony, Young Rider or Masters** - Please notify Pony and/or Young Rider or Master on your entry form or in riders notes on Equestrian Entries

**Grounds** only open from Thursday midday onwards

1. NO DOGS -NO EXCEPTIONS No dogs in trucks or cars on grounds
2. Competitors and spectators attending this competition do so at their own risk. The organising committee disclaims all liability in the event of any accident, or damage to any horse, rider, spectator, person, and/or property.
3. Entries must be on official ESNZ entry forms with the appropriate stickers complete with signature, or entered through Equestrian Entries
4. All Classes are run under ESNZ & DNZ Rules
5. Safety hats must be worn at all times when competing and schooling at Woodhill Sands. No top hats may be worn in any competition.
6. Champions will be decided over all tests in that level excluding class 38 & 39
7. Dressage Waitemata Champions are awarded in each level, and include additional and separate championships in Level 1 for CN/C1 riders, and Level 2 for CN/C1/C2 riders – all championships will be decided by a points system, details of which will be available in our programme. Only one champion is allowed per combination, riders to nominate after the results if they have won two championships. A combination that has previously won a Category Restricted championship at our competition is not eligible to win the same championship again. Young Rider and Pony champions will be decided on a points system, details of which will be in the programme. In the event of a tie the horse with the highest average percentage will be the winner.
8. AMS Saddlery Pony and Young Rider Performance League [For more details](#) – Points for this series will be calculated from Classes 38 & 39 for Levels 1 & 2, and from the Super 5 tests for other levels.
9. Late entries will be accepted in order of receipt & payment– wait lists may apply and riders will be advised should they be waitlisted.
10. Only horses/ponies entered in the competition are allowed on the ground unless prior consent has been given by the OC
11. Bridle numbers and Stallion tags must be worn at all times when ridden. All horses / ponies on grounds must have an identification tag on them at all times when not under saddle, with rider details and contact number.
12. The Dressage Waitemata Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to change the programme.
13. Abuse of horses or officials will not be tolerated.
14. Scratchings to be advised either through Equestrian Entries or email [info@dressagewaitemata.co.nz](mailto:info@dressagewaitemata.co.nz) with rider and horse name and bridle number and details of classes entered. (During event you can also text 0272917492) A full refund will be given if scratching advised before close of entries (9pm Friday 18th November). After November 19th a maximum of 75% will be refunded but only if the request is received within 7 days of the competition and accompanied by a vet, farrier or doctor's certificate, or at OC discretion
15. CN/C1 riders competing in Level 1 and CN/C1/C2 in Level 2 will compete with the open riders in their respective tests, but will be eligible for a separate set of rosettes. They are still eligible for prize money & overall rosettes should they place overall in the test but must choose which rosette they collect, open or restricted.
16. All refunds and prize money will be issued after the show and paid by direct credit.
17. Maximum of 2 starts per day on any one horse with the exception of class 38 or 39 being the 3<sup>rd</sup> allowed on Sunday.
18. Pony classes restricted to riders as per DNZ Rule 463.3. Adults may ride ponies in horse classes.
19. Masters. For riders 50 yrs and over. Age as at 1 August
20. All Super 5 League classes must be ridden from memory, no callers allowed.
21. Arena familiarisation: Thursday 5pm – 6pm, Friday 7.30am – 8 am  
Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace only around the exterior of the arenas during these times.  
Designated warm up arena is open during hours of daylight and is ONLY for the use of horses/ponies entered in this competition
22. Lunging area- on grass at end of arenas by water jump . If in doubt check with office.
