Horse Facilities

- Paddocks: 26
- Uncovered yards: 280
- Covered yards: 54 and 16 stallion stables
- Bedding: Bedding in yards, usually more available.
- Wheelbarrows: Some available but best to bring your own.
- Washdown facilities: Washdown facilities spread around yards.
- Taps: In washdown and throughout yards.
- Hoses: In washdown areas.
- Hay: Can be delivered to grounds by local supplier. Must pre book, see website for details.

Venue Facilities

- Parking: Plenty
- Showers: 8- by office and far end of yards
- Toilets: 10- by office and yards.
- Dogs: Dogs allowed but must be on leashes by arenas.
- Food/Coffee: Usually coffee and a food available
- Office: By arenas

Riding Facilities

- Arena surface: sand/pumice, freestyles on grass.
- Indoor/ Outdoor arenas: Outdoor

Local Facilities

- Supermarket: Woolworths in Spa Rd, Taupo (17mins drive)
- Equestrian Supplies/Stockfood:
Taupo Saddlery in Waikato St (17mins drive).
Farmlands in Tauhara Rd, Taupo (15mins drive).

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Rider Tips

- You can hire paddocks but they are small and usually have little grass so bring plenty of hay.
- Hell Pizza in Taupo delivers to NEC!
- It is a long walk from the camping to the office and competition area so I usually bring a bicycle.
- Plenty of space to warm up but the ground and arenas can become hard.
- Taupo can get very cold at night so even in the summer bring plenty of warm clothes and rugs.
- There is jet boating just around the corner of the venue so that is a fun excursion.
- Bring plenty of first aid stuff for you and your horse. I had an emergency with my horse a few years ago and the vet took over an hour to get there.

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Facilities

Taupo is open to riders travelling if they want to stop for a break or stay overnight on the way somewhere.

Please check what else is on at the facility before arriving.

These prices are for all riders using the grounds and are paid at the facility.

Horses x Nights = Total

Ground Use/Facility Use fee @ \$10 per horse/per day

or @ \$15 per horse for duration(multiple days)

Includes use of Charisma Hall and Kitchen

Stallion Stables (16) @ \$20 per horse per night

Covered Yards (118) @ \$20 per horse per night

Paddocks (23) @ \$15 per horse per night

Open Pens (280) @ \$10 per horse per night

People x Nights = Total

Camping @ \$5 per person per night (under 5yrs – no charge)

(Trucks/Floats/Caravans/Tents)

Portacoms – 7 with total 13 beds @ \$20 per person per night

BYO Linen

(must be booked with management – to ensure room availability)

Power Connection – Trucks/Caravans @ \$10 per connection per night
